As we get closer to the meeting, HFSA will continue to monitor the status of COVID-19, particularly the status of local directives at the Gaylord National Harbor, in Prince George's County and in the state of Maryland.

Additionally, HFSA will offer a virtual option for those preferring to experience ASM 2022 virtually, though it will not be as robust as the in-person meeting.

Masks and COVID-19 Vaccinations

While masks and vaccinations are not currently required while attending ASM 2022, vaccinations are encouraged. HFSA will follow any local directives in place at the time of the meeting at the Gaylord National Harbor, in Prince George's County and in the state of Maryland.
