



Up to 75 travel grants of \$1500 each (Early Career/trainee) may be available for full-time trainees and Early Career members within 7 years of receiving their doctoral degree are eligible to apply for a travel grant to the HFSA Annual Scientific Sessions.

To be eligible, individual must be: 1) a member or join HFSA to be considered. 2) An Early Career member within 7 years of receiving their doctoral degree OR a full-time trainee at the time of the September 2016 meeting. Preference will be given to those who submit abstracts.
