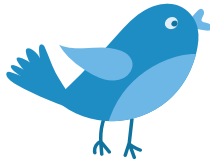

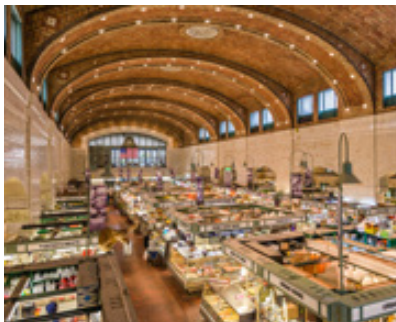

The closest airport is Cleveland Hopkins International Airport (about 13 miles). The hotels do not provide shuttles.















